New C6A1 Flex General Purpose Machine Guns for the Canadian Armed Forces

Colt Canada is pleased to announce the award by the Government of Canada for Engineering Services and supply of C6A1 Flex weapons and accessories. Since its inception in 1976, Colt Canada (formerly Diemaco Inc.) has played a very significant support role with the Canadian Armed Forces C6 General Purpose Machine-Gun. As a member of Canada's Munitions Supply Program (MSP), Colt Canada has supplied quality small arms weapons systems, spares parts, accessories and support for DND's entire fleet including C7/C8, C6, C9 and .50 cal.

Utilizing the Technical Data Package provided under license from Fabrique National Hestal Belgium to the Government of Canada, Colt Canada has provided full support of the current C6 fleet since 1976. This support ranged from full rebuild and overhaul of the fleet including the supply of barrels, spare parts and accessories. All of the engineering, tooling and testing was conducted at Colt Canada's Kitchener facility.

With almost half of the current C6 fleet having reached a non-repairable state, Colt Canada is perfectly capable of supplying and supporting the next fleet of C6A1 weapon. A support machinegun has not been manufactured in Canada for our Armed Forces since World War II. Colt Canada and its skilled employees are honoured to have received this opportunity from the Government of Canada. We are proud of our members of the Canadian Armed Forces and excited and optimistic about working with them on a successful C6A1 program.
